She enjoyed the outdoors a lot. Hunting, fishing, camping, and eventually four-wheeling. There was never a mud puddle that she didn't go through several times whether in the pickup or on her four-wheeler. She was an avid reader of Stephen King, the scarier the better. She also enjoyed refinishing old furniture with her husband. She made all kinds of pillows, afghans, latchhook, and scrapbooking. She was the keeper of all sentimental items. She loved to give people a hard time in the grocery store or at the bank. It was her humor and sarcasm that would draw people to her and her smile would light up a room.

Karen is survived by her daughters, Karrie and Katie; grandsons, Maximus and Bobby Dascomb; mother, Lorraine Tiller; brothers, Rocky Tiller and Randy Tiller; sister-in-law, Connie Tiller; and numerous nephews.
